RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR CEMETERIES OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC
ARCHDIOCESE OF BOSTON

SECTION VII
SUB SECTION 7-D:

No coping, curbing, fencing, hedging, borders, plantings or enclosures of any kind shall be allowed on or around any lot. The cemetery authority reserves the right to remove same if so erected, planted or placed.

SECTION XI
SUB SECTION 11-F:

Lawns shall NOT be disturbed for any purpose except upon the express written permission of the Cemetery Authority.

SUB SECTION 11-G:

Ornaments and flower vases: The right is reserved to regulate the method of decorations of lots so that a uniform beauty may be maintained.

All lot holders and persons within the Cemeteries, and all lots sold, shall be subject to said Rules and Regulations and such amendments or alterations thereof or additions thereto as shall be adopted by the ARCHBISHOP OF BOSTON from time to time; and the reference to these Rules and Regulations in the document conveying the right of interment shall have the same force and effect as if set forth in full therein.
