From I-495-N:

Go to exit 4 (Rt-105)
Turn right onto
Rt-105/So. Main St.

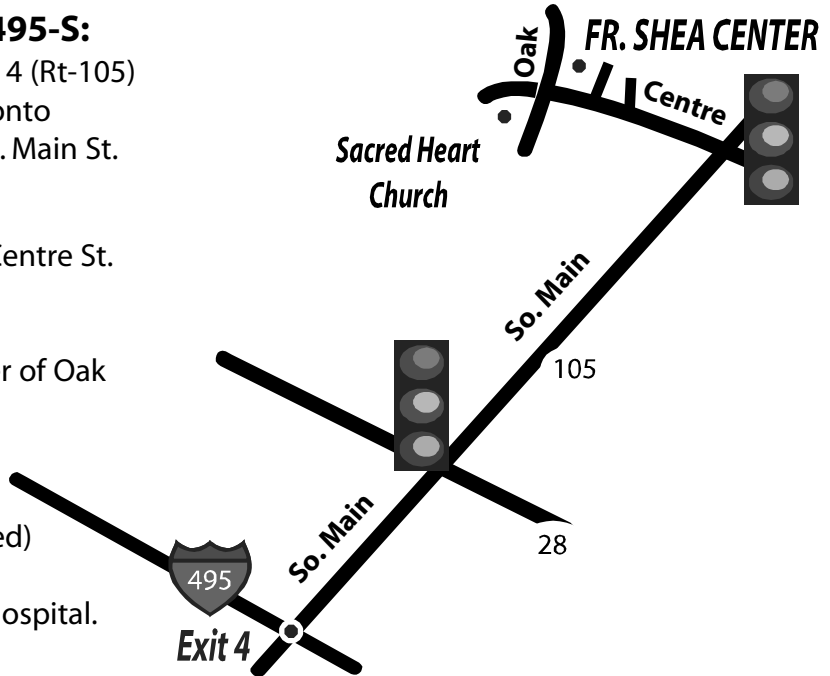
From I-495-S:

Go to exit 4 (Rt-105)
Turn left onto
Rt-105/So. Main St.

Go straight through first set of lights.
At second set of lights turn left onto Centre St.
Continue on Centre St.
Take the third right to go on Oak St.
The Father Shea Center is at the corner of Oak
and Centre St.

Parking:

Available in front of Fr. Shea Ctr. (limited)
Behind Parish Hall (next door)
Across street at the former St. Luke's Hospital.
At Sacred Heart Church
